Due to the current Coronavirus situation we have had to make some slight changes to how we are doing things at Preschool. We appreciate your co-operation in complying with the new systems.

- On arrival please wait outside by the Small gate at the bottom of the outside area. A member of staff will be outside to collect your child/children.
- We request that parents do not enter the play area or the Preschool building and leave once your child/children have been collected by the staff.
- Children and staff will wash and sanitise hands on entry to the preschool building.
- Children are encouraged to wash and sanitise their hands regularly whilst at preschool.
- Any child showing signs of Coronavirus symptoms; new and continuous cough, high temperature, sudden loss of taste or smell is required to stay at home and isolate for 14 days as per Gove
- rnement guidance and obtain a test if necessary. The child can return once a negative test result is received and the child is well again.
- If a member of your household is showing symptoms you must keep the child off preschool as the whole household isolates as per the Government guidelines.
- Should a child receive a positive test for Coronavirus, Preschool will inform the relative authorities and take guidance from them. Due to the current lower numbers of children we are all considered to be one bubble.
- Please ensure you send a change of clothes to preschool for your child as we are unable to lend our clothes to you under the current circumstances.
